HIGHLAND SKY away in good order, tracked the front runners from along the insideroute during the initial stages, was shifted to the outside after spinning onto the backstretch, eventually getting set up towards path two, loosely drafted off the right shoulder of the pacesetter until deep onto turn two, tipped out in path three during the final stages of the run around that bend, in preparation for the stretch drive, was goaded into swinging approximately six wide by an errant RED KNIGHT stepping onto the head of the stretch, by now having been set down, took charge during the ensuing furlong, extended the lead even further before winding up geared down for the last seventy yards. RED KNIGHT prompted the pace three wide, mildly urged, poked a head in front in the general area of the five-sixteenths, came was under assault from the winner right afterwards, sputtered about five wide into the lane, with the top one following suit by moving much wider into the lane itself, had the pilot lose the whip after being straightened away, proved no match, stayed on for the place. TURCO BRAVO (CHI) established the top after being put to an abbreviated ride at the start, took up residence along the outer border of the two path, showed the way, accompanied by the runner up to the outside, relinquished a short distance from the quarter pole, backed away steadily down the stretch. REDICEAN (GB) flip-flopped paths with the winner early on the backstretch, stayed put along the rail thereafter all the way to the end of the second bend, drafted about three wide into the lane with little left then was allowed to fade away, rider appying a protective hold.
